RANDALL HALE CAPTURES CIRCUIT RING IN FIRST CIRCUIT TOURNAMENT EVER

Casino champion winner decided in the final event's heads up

Randall Hall has never played any WSOP Circuit tournament before. However, today he took a shot at his first tournament, and ended up defeating 254 players to claim the winner title, as well as his first ring and a first-place prize as his first WSOP cash ever.

"I don't play tournaments. This is my first WSOP Circuit tournament. For me it was just something to do. It was fun."

Although Hall's first experience in tournaments will be one to remember, he doesn't plan on playing more tournaments.

"It is highly unlikely I will be playing more tournaments. I just like to play cash."

Another highlight of the last event was Randall Davenport's second-place finish. With his score of 72.5, Davenport needed to accumulate 33 additional points to surpass Carl Masters's score of 105 and win the Casino Championship. He needed to get second or better in this event, and managed to perfectly do so, taking over Carl Masters' top spot on the venue leaderboard and claiming the seat into the Global Casino Championship.
