## Spain's Adrian Garcia Wins Event #: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em

Adrian Garcia rides Day 2 chip lead to victory.

Adrian Garcia wasted no time collecting his first career WSOP Circuit ring. Garcia entered Day 2 of Event #3: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em as the chip leader with eight players remaining. It took Garcia just an hour a half on Day 2 to eliminate his final opponent from the tournament. Garcia earned a WSOP Circuit ring and the top payout of \$14,801 for his win.

Garcia is a professional poker player from Spain. This marked Garcia's second career WSOP cash and first final table. Garcia joins Taylor Hart and Andrew Dubuque at the top of the Bally's Casino Championship leaderboard. Each has 50 points for their first place finishes. The player with the most points at at the end of the series will earn a free seat to the \$1 million guaranteed 2019 Global Casino Championship. It's still early and there are a lot points still to be earned with only three of the 13 point-eligible events complete.
