ROBBIE CALHOUN WINS FIRST WSOP CIRCUIT RING

Calhoun is transitioning from online poker to live poker, and is off to a fast start.

27 March, 2019 (Las Vegas) – About three weeks ago, Robbie Calhoun moved from Spokane, Washington to Las Vegas. Today, the first time he ever finished in the money in a WSOP Circuit event, he won his first career ring, earning \$16,654.

Calhoun, a longtime online pro, has just recently started trying to play more live poker, and it's already paying off for him. "It feels good," he said of his first Circuit ring, and the victory offers a sense of validation to his choice to play more live poker. "The biggest thing that feels great about this is trying to explain to my parents what I do for a living. They always knew I did good online, but with the little bit of live experience I have, they'd just say, 'Why do you win? You never win when you play live.' So now I can really show them it's possible to win live."
