TOM GOTTLIEB CAPTURES FIRST TOURNAMENT VICTORY IN EVENT #2

Gottlieb takes home his first Circuit ring along with \$34,269.

Tom Gottlieb took down his first tournament this evening while competing at the Harrah's Atlantic City Circuit series. The 33-year-old poker professional moved from Israel five years ago to play poker full time. Today, he defeated a field of 483 entrants in Event #2, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em, a multi-flight event, to claim his first Circuit ring and Circuit title.

Gottlieb started the final table as one of the shortest stacks. However, he managed to slowly win pots, eventually taking the lead. The poker pro is mostly a cash game player but has been playing tournaments too lately.

"I've been playing tournaments for a year and a half. I've been playing cash for ten years. I'm mostly a cash game player, but with cash games getting a little tougher over the years, I want to expand and try other stuff."

Gottlieb plans to take a break and enjoy his win.

"I think I'm going to calm down and enjoy my win for a little bit. I won a ring and I'm good with that. There's no rush. I'm not chasing more rings. I will definitely be playing the WSOP in Vegas this summer though."

Gottlieb collects \$34,269 for his victory along with his Circuit ring.
