## NIKOLAOS PLATIS IS THE CHAMPION OF EVENT #3

Platis takes home his first Circuit ring along with \$22,732.

Nikolaos Platis has just earned his first WSOP Circuit ring, along with the second biggest WSOP score of his poker resume, and his first live tournament win. He outlasted 287 competitors to claim the top prize of \$22,732.

The 26-year-old put up a good fight to claim the title. Indeed, when the heads-up portion of play began, his opponent, John Lytle had a massive chip lead. However, Platis didn't give up, and slowly grinded his way back up, eventually taking the lead and winning the tournament.

"I think I had 1,8 million and he had 6 million or something like that. I just kept taking down a lot of small pots. I took my time."

Platis is mostly a cash game player and intends to take a shot at the Main Event next, this weekend.
