KEVIN BOESEL IS THE CHAMPION OF EVENT #7

He claims his first Circuit ring and \$6,281.

Kevin Boesel has earned his first Circuit ring in Event #7: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em \$100 Bounty, after topping a field of 91 entries.

"It feels great. It was a short field, everything went great for me today," said Boesel after closing out his win.

Boesel started the final day as one of shortest stacks. However, that didn't stop him from grinding his way back up to the top and winning the tournament.

"I was one of the lower stacks but nobody had a real overwhelming lead, so I was right in there. I just made a couple of hands early and was able to work my way back up to the top."

The stakes were high at the final table, and Boesel had to defeat bracelet winner and two-time ring winner Robert Cheung as well as three-time ring winner Paul Sokoloff, to claim the winner title.

"I did check before the day starts, and my two last opponents were the two highest earners that I noticed so it doesn't surprise me they were there at the end. I've had my fair share of wins or luck. I just probably don't get out as much as most people so my stats aren't up there, but this will add to it a little bit."

Boesel wasn't planning to play the Main Event, but after his victory, he might change his plans.

“I’m supposed to leave Saturday but now that I’ve won this, maybe I will extend my trip a little bit.”
