RYAN HEROLD EARNS HIS FIRST FIRST CIRCUIT RING

He takes home \$15,998, his biggest live score.

Ryan Herold earned his first Circuit ring after taking down Event #11: \$600 No-Limit Hold'em. He outlasted 81 runners to claim the first-place prize of \$15,998 along with the title.

Although Herold doesn't play poker for a living, he has been constantly working on his game, and today his efforts paid off.

"It feels amazing. I've been working pretty hard the past couple of years. I still have a full-time job. But I'm constantly working on my game. I play online all the time. I finally got it done. It feels good."

Herold transitioned from cash games to tournaments a couple of years ago.

"I transitioned to the tournament scenes a of couple of years ago. This is my third year playing tournaments. It's different and I love it so much better."

When the three-handed portion of play began, Herold managed to defeat two champions to claim the title. Indeed, two-time ring winners Alex Rocha and Wayne Lovell were his final two opponents.

"Alex is a phenomenal opponent. I played with him in the past and Lovell is a beast. He is a very tough opponent as well. It was tough three-handed. A lot of battling back and forth. I ran good in a couple of spots. The deck came my way."
