GREG BAIRD WINS MULTI-BAG BONUS EVENT AT HAMMOND

Baird wins second ring in a Multi-Fight Event.

After players flooded in for six starting flights, Greg Baird closed another multi-flight tournament to claim his second WSOP Circuit ring. The Chicago native navigated his way through an 894-player field in the \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Multi-Bag Bonus and earned \$49,402 for his first-place finish.

"It's a really great feeling," said Baird. "I've been working on my game a lot and I must be doing something right."

Baird has WSOP results dating back to 2007, when he cashed in a \$5,000 No-Limit Hold'em bracelet event. But over the last few years, Baird's volume has picked up and he began to put up more consistent results. He final tabled the Hammond Seniors event in 2015 and a \$580 No-Limit Hold'em Six-Max Event in February 2017 at Coconut Creek, where he also picked up his first ring just last year.

"You have to run good, that's the key," Baird said about winning in multi-flight events. "I'm excited that I was able to win another, this just makes the first one's not a fluke."

Baird went into the final table with the chip lead and never lost it. Once play was down to the final three players, Baird held over 12 million chips with only 13.6 million in play. The three-way battle lasted a little longer than expected after Baird doubled up both Eric Tran and Leo Birov, but play ended one level later giving Baird his second Circuit win.

"I figured if Jerry (Gumila) could win a ring here, I could too," Baird said with a chuckle.
