JOSH JOHNSON WINS 2ND CIRCUIT RING AT CHEROKEE

Businessman and poker pro from Morrisville takes down the 6-Max event

With a supportive rail behind him, Josh Johnson has won his second career World Series of Poker Circuit ring after taking down Event #5: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em 6-Max. Johnson pocketed \$40,330 for the win, locking up his biggest career cash and almost doubling his overall earnings.

"It feels good. I was down to one one thousand chip in this tournament. The blinds were 300/600. It was early on, and I just kept grinding. Kept pushing, kept believing. Here it is, and I'm lookin' for another one," smiled Johnson.

Johnson runs his own business, but considers himself a part-time professional poker player. As for the game itself, Johnson prefers to do things his own way. "I don't read, I don't study. I play my own game and it works. I like to win. I'm an athlete and I like to win. There's a lot of competition in this game."

After a fun heads-up battle against Josh Benfield where the two players chopped up many pots after getting their chips in the middle, Johnson finally sealed the deal with ace-queen. He was ahead the whole way, but rivered an ace for good measure to win the title.
