JON ALDALUR WINS FIRST CAREER CIRCUIT RING AND \$24,298

The Spaniard came to Las Vegas to play tournaments as a birthday gift to himself.

15 December, 2019 (Las Vegas) – Jon Aldalur is the latest World Series of Poker Circuit champion! He earned his first Circuit ring in only his second Circuit cash at Harrah's, Las Vegas, and he did it just two days before his birthday.

"I'm in shock," a joyful Aldalur said after securing his victory.

Aldalur hails from Spain. He and his girlfriend are in the midst of an extended vacation to New York, and Aldalur took a few days to come to Las Vegas to play the WSOP Circuit for his birthday. Coming here on his own took a little convincing – "She was doubting," he admitted with a slight smile – but it paid off, as he earned \$24,298.

Aldalur is a recreational player who works in commercial auto sales. But he's a fairly serious amateur. "I play a lot of tournaments," he said. "I just like to play poker."
