Corey Paggeot Earns His First Circuit Ring

Corey Paggeot has just won the 12th event at the Harrah's Las Vegas World Series of Poker Circuit. The Michigan native bested 192 players in the \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack Turbo event to pocket \$15,447 and earn his first career WSOP Circuit gold ring. He also earns 50 Casino Championship points for his victory, bringing his series total to 55 points.

This marked Paggeot's sixth and largest World Series of Poker cash. Paggeot defeated a tough final table to earn the victory, but the toughest challenge may have been his heads up opponent. Paggeot had to get through World Series of Poker bracelet winner Longshen Tan to take home the hardware. Tan won his bracelet in a \$1,500 no-limit hold'em event at the 2018 WSOP. Tan was also hunting for his first ring in this event, but had to settle for the runner-up prize of \$9,537.
