General Rules

Players will start with 5000 in chips. Each level will last 40 minutes. Breaks will last 10 minutes. Dinner breaks will be added at the discretion of the tournament director. If at 2 am the tournament is not completed, the remaining players, and the Tournament Director will make the decision as to whether or not to finish the tournament that night, or have everyone return the following day at 2pm. 3% of the total prize pool is withheld from all events for tournament staff.

*The first place finisher will receive a \$5,150 Buy-In to the main event at the 2009 WSOP Circuit Event at Horseshoe Southern Indiana (October 31, 2009) in addition to first place prize money.
