- \$365 buy-in (\$300 prize pool + \$65 administrative fee) Fee includes any and all staffing / dealer fees, add-ons and rake.
- Players will start with 10,000 in tournament chips. Players may choose to start on and/or re-enter any flight.
- Registration will remain open until the start the start of level nine (9), eliminated players may re-enter until this time at the Registration. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter or be subject to disqualification. Players may forfeit their current stack to re-enter.
- Any player who has not taken a hand by the first break may be considered a "no show" and may have their chips removed from play and
 may not be eligible to participate and may not be eligible for a refund.
- There will be a 15-minute break every 2 hours of play on Day 1 and for every 3 levels of play on Day 2.
- Winner receives a WSOP Circuit Ring. All "Ring" events qualify to earn points for the 2018 WSOP Global Casino Championship.
- Day 1 will play until the completion of level 15 or approximately 12% of the field. There is no dinner break on Day 1.
- All Flights will merge for Day 2 on Sunday, March 18th at 12:00 PM. There will be a 60-minute dinner break after 6 hours of play. In the event the final table is unable to reach a conclusion as scheduled, The Tournament Director in his sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
