\$1,700 buy-in (\$1,515 prize pool + \$185 administrative fee)

- Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips.
- Administrative fee includes all staffing/dealer fees, and rake.
- This is a WSOPC "Ring" Event. The winner will receive an invitation to the Tournament of Champions.
- All flights will play 17 levels or down to 10% of the field on Day 1, whichever comes first. Players will play into the money on each flight. The remaining prize pool not awarded on Day 1 will carry over to be merged with all flights for Day 2.
- Day 2 will resume on Sunday, April 28th at 12:00 PM merging players from both flights. Day 3 will resume on Monday, April 29th at 12:00 PM.
- If a player is eliminated during the registration period that player may re-enter the same event 2 times per flight.
- There will be a 15 minute break after levels 3, 6, 12, 15, 19, 21, 25, and 27.
- Registration will remain open until the beginning of level 13.
- Players must forfeit chips BEFORE bagging if they wish to play in another flight for same event.
